The NMTIA has voted to award, for the first time, the Juan José Peña Scholarship to allow one NMTIA member in good standing to attend a national interpreters/translators conference. The scholarship amount is \$500. The recipient will be a member who has never before attended a national conference and commits to taking NMTIA materials to the conference, and reporting back on their experience to membership.
